- Keep practice sessions short and positive.
- Offer help when a new skill is being learned.
- Encourage effort rather than perfect results.

Safety Reminder

Adult supervision is recommended for all cutting activities.

- Use child-safe blunt-tip scissors.

- Stop the activity if the child becomes tired or frustrated.

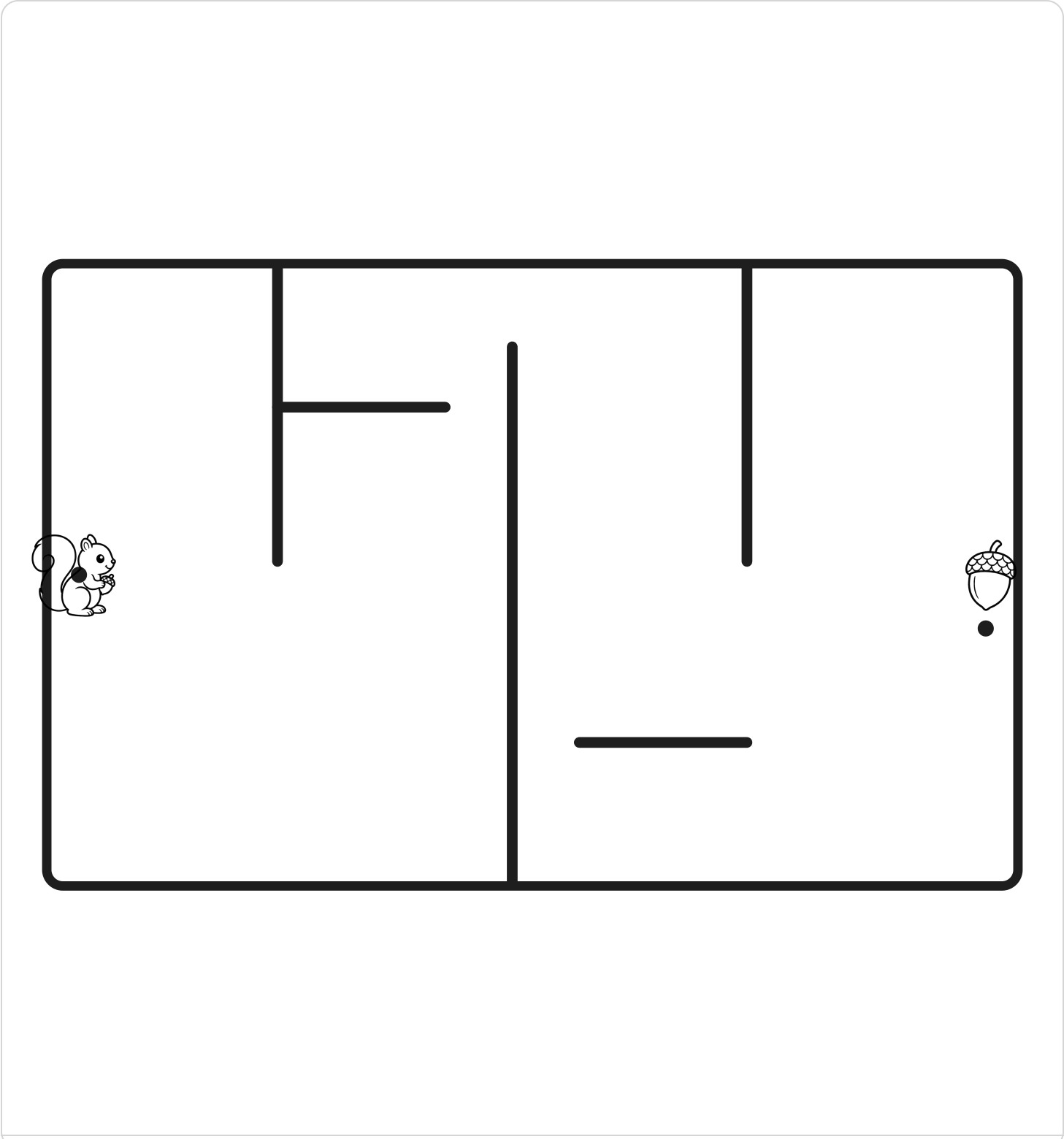
Help the Squirrel Find the Acorn
