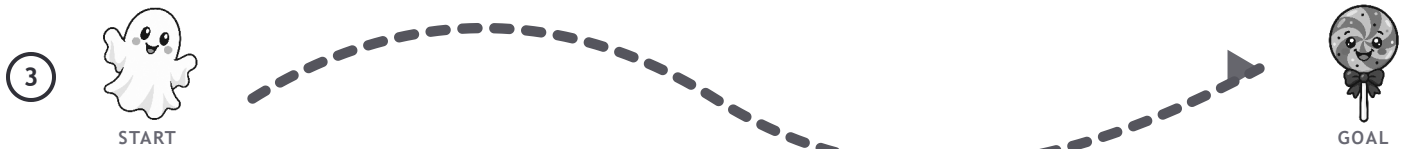
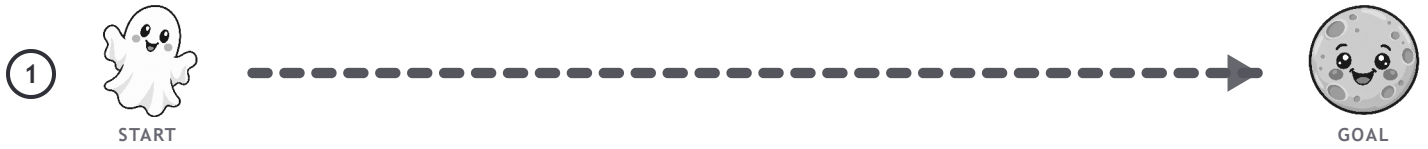

CIRCLE



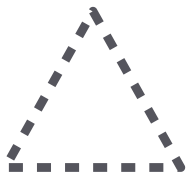
Trace the round shape.

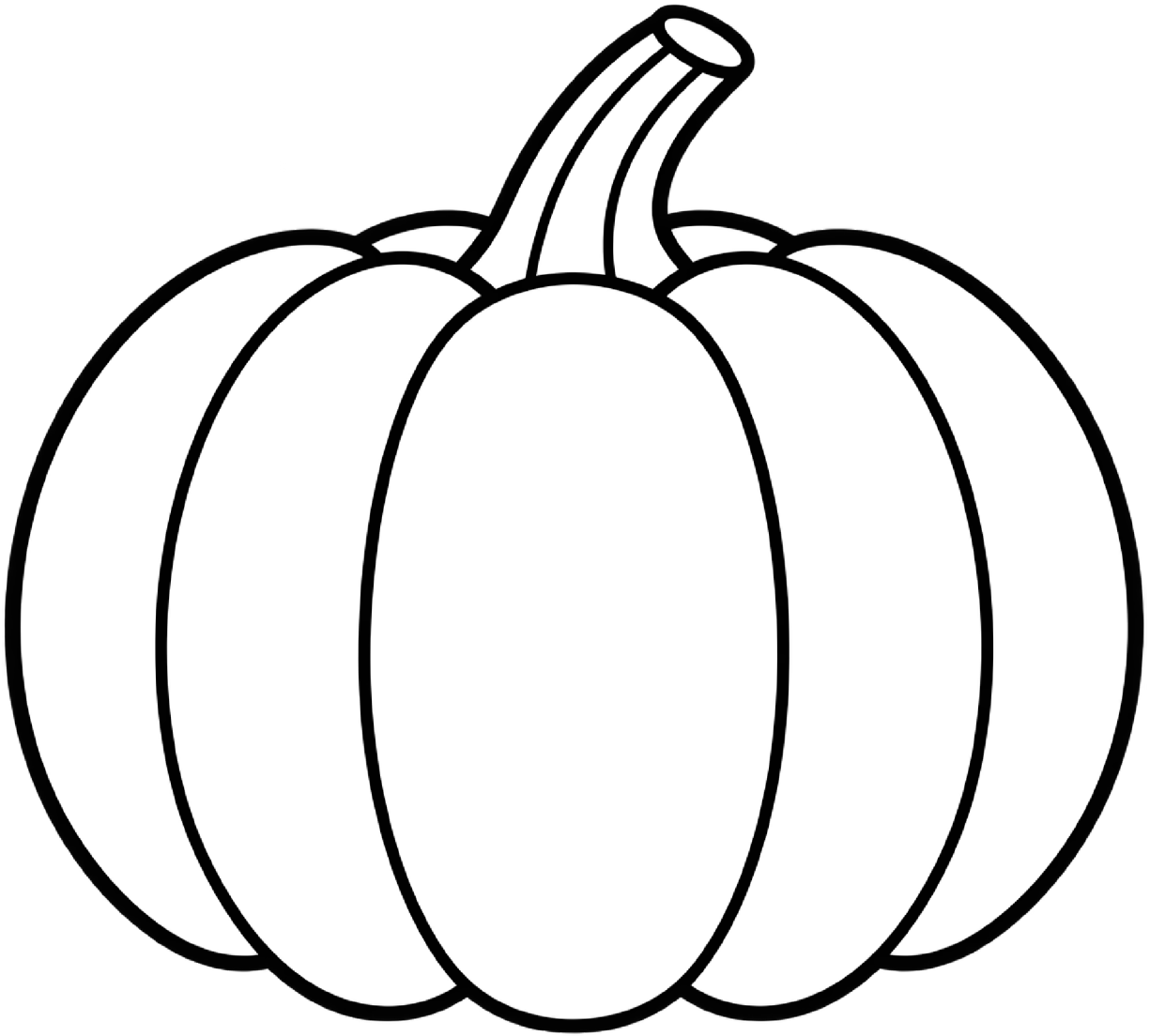






Design Your Jack-O'-Lantern
