Use 1-3 pages at a time. Follow your child's pace.

Caregiver notes + safety

Choose a small starting point, keep the pencil moving, and celebrate careful trying.

1. How to Use

- Print the pages you need at 100% scale.
- Offer crayons, pencils, or washable markers.
- Talk, point, and let your child work at their own pace.

2. Start Here

Begin with Pages 03-06 for simple paths, matching, same-picture, and size practice. Add one page at a time.

3. Make It Easier

- Cover extra choices while your child focuses.
- Say each picture name slowly.
- Model one example, then let your child try.

4. Add a Challenge

- Ask, "How do you know?"
- Invite your child to count aloud.
- Ask them to name a new example.

5. Safety

Adult supervision is recommended. Use only child-safe scissors and age-appropriate washable art materials. Keep cut paper pieces and small loose materials away from children who may put objects in their mouths. Stop or simplify if a child becomes tired or frustrated. These worksheets are learning activities, not a developmental assessment. No pins, sharp tools, toothpicks, or puncture activities.

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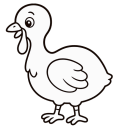

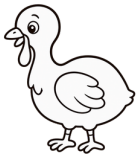

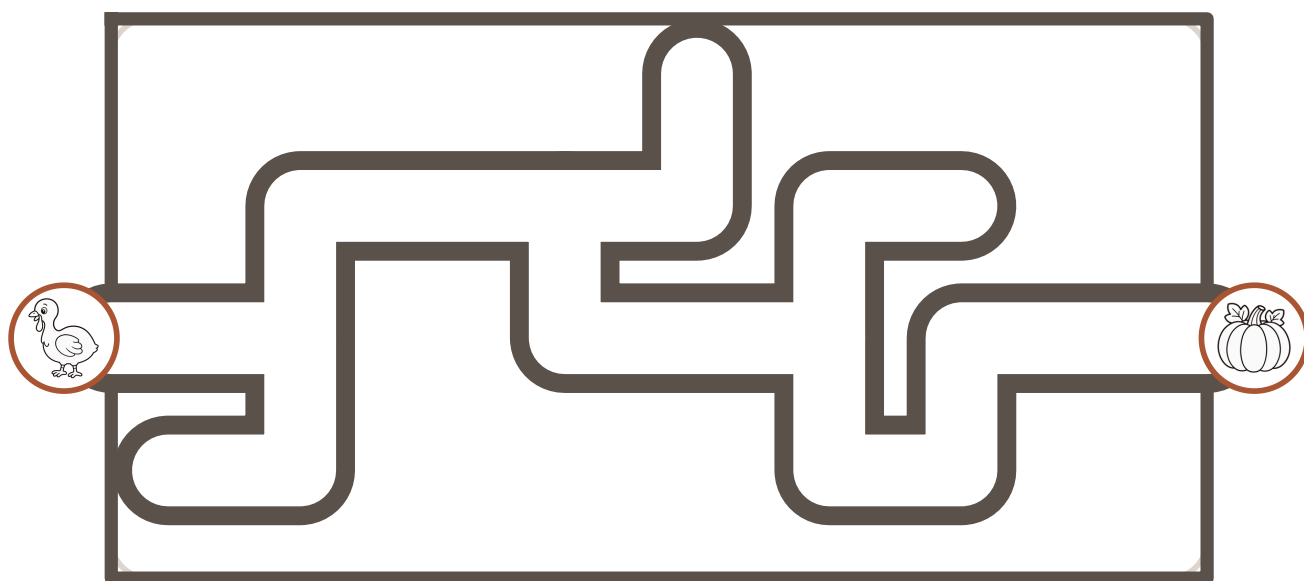
