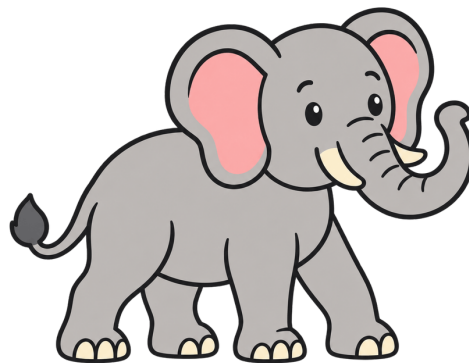
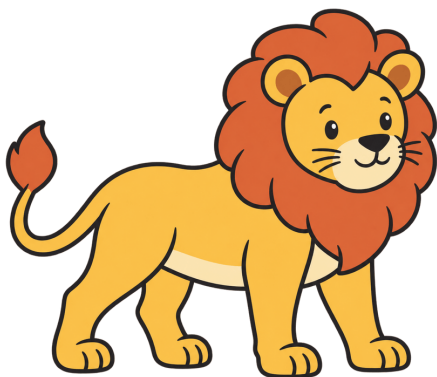

How to Use This Pack

Start where your child feels comfortable.

Our trail: **Spot** → **Match** → **Compare** → **Count** → **Trace** → **Explore**

- ① Choose one page at a time.
- ② Read the short instruction aloud.
- ③ Let the child point before drawing or circling.
- ④ Stop when attention fades.
- ⑤ Reuse favorite pages rather than rushing through the pack.

Grown-Up Note

Ages are a guide, not a test. Reduce choices, pre-cut pieces, or let the child answer by pointing whenever needed.

Safety First

- Adult supervision is required.
- Use child-appropriate crayons, markers, glue and scissors.
- An adult should supervise all cutting and gluing.
- Pre-cut pieces for children who are not ready to use scissors.
- Keep small cut pieces away from children who may mouth objects and from younger siblings.
- Follow the age and safety instructions on all art supplies.
- Wash hands after craft activities.
- Stop using damaged or unsafe materials.

For younger learners, start with two target animals. For older learners, ask which animal was easiest or hardest to find.

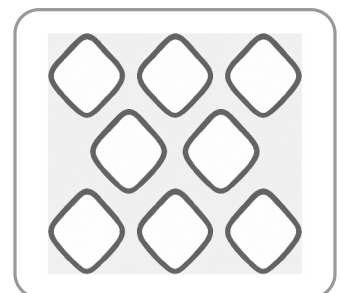
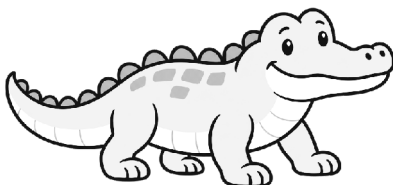
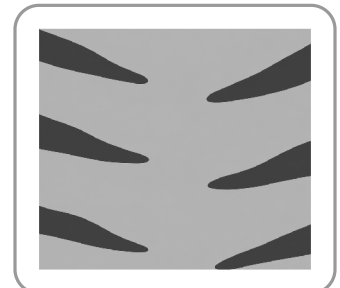
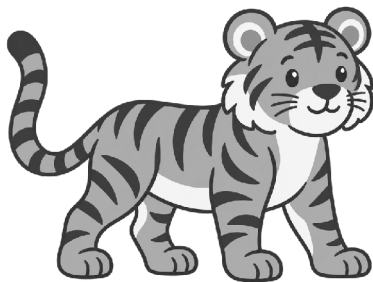
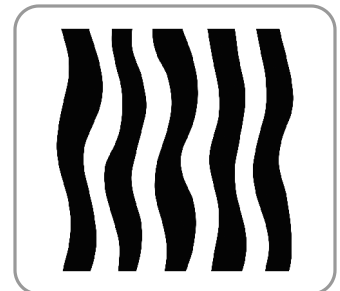
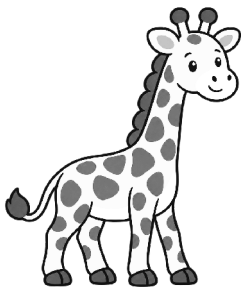
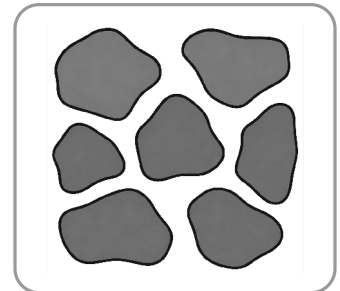

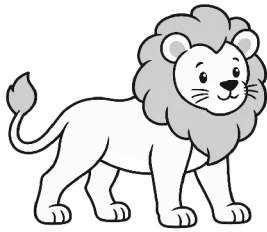


Grown-Up Guide

Start at the dot. Trace to the star.

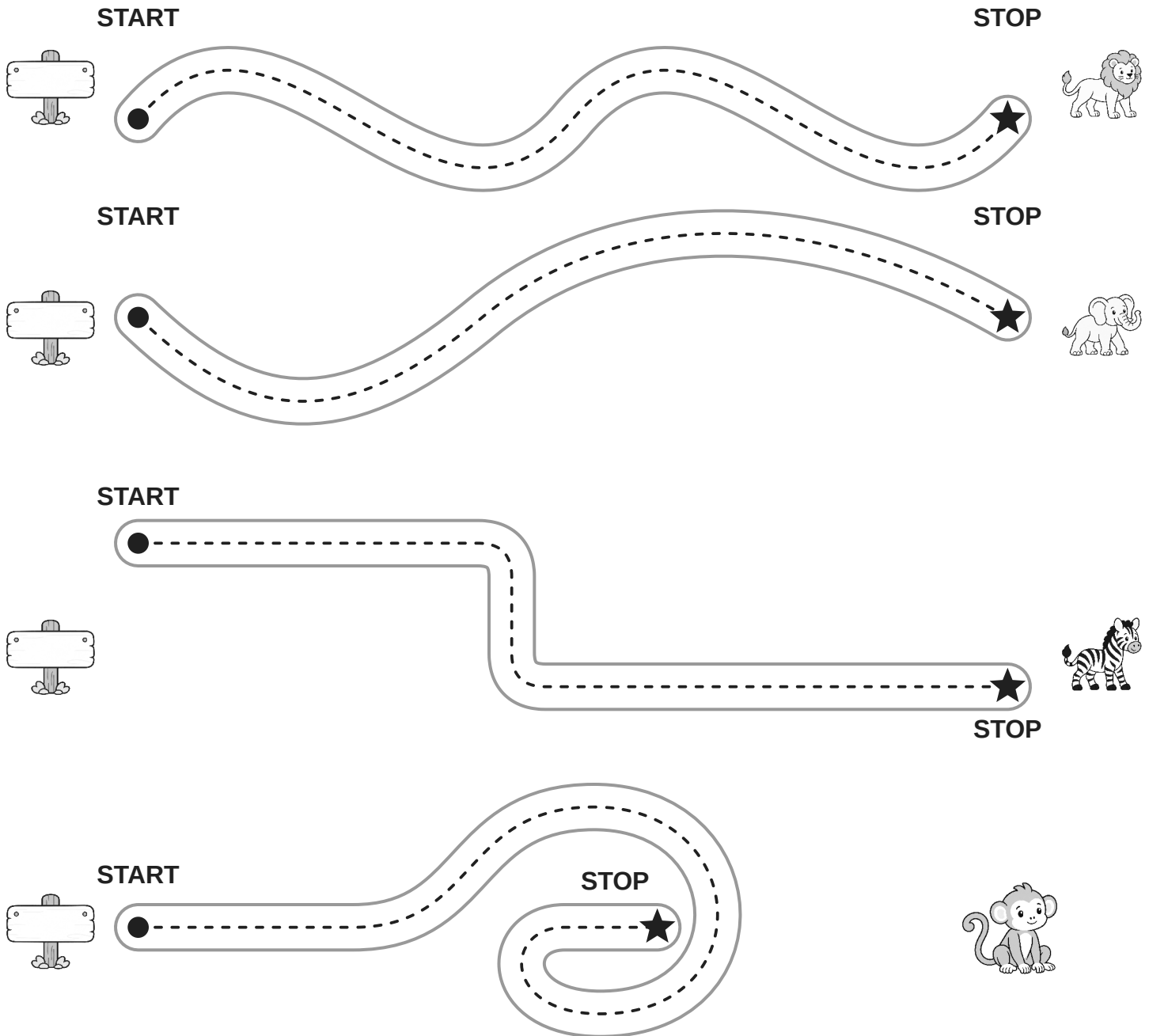


Grown-Up Guide

Trace each trail from START to STOP.



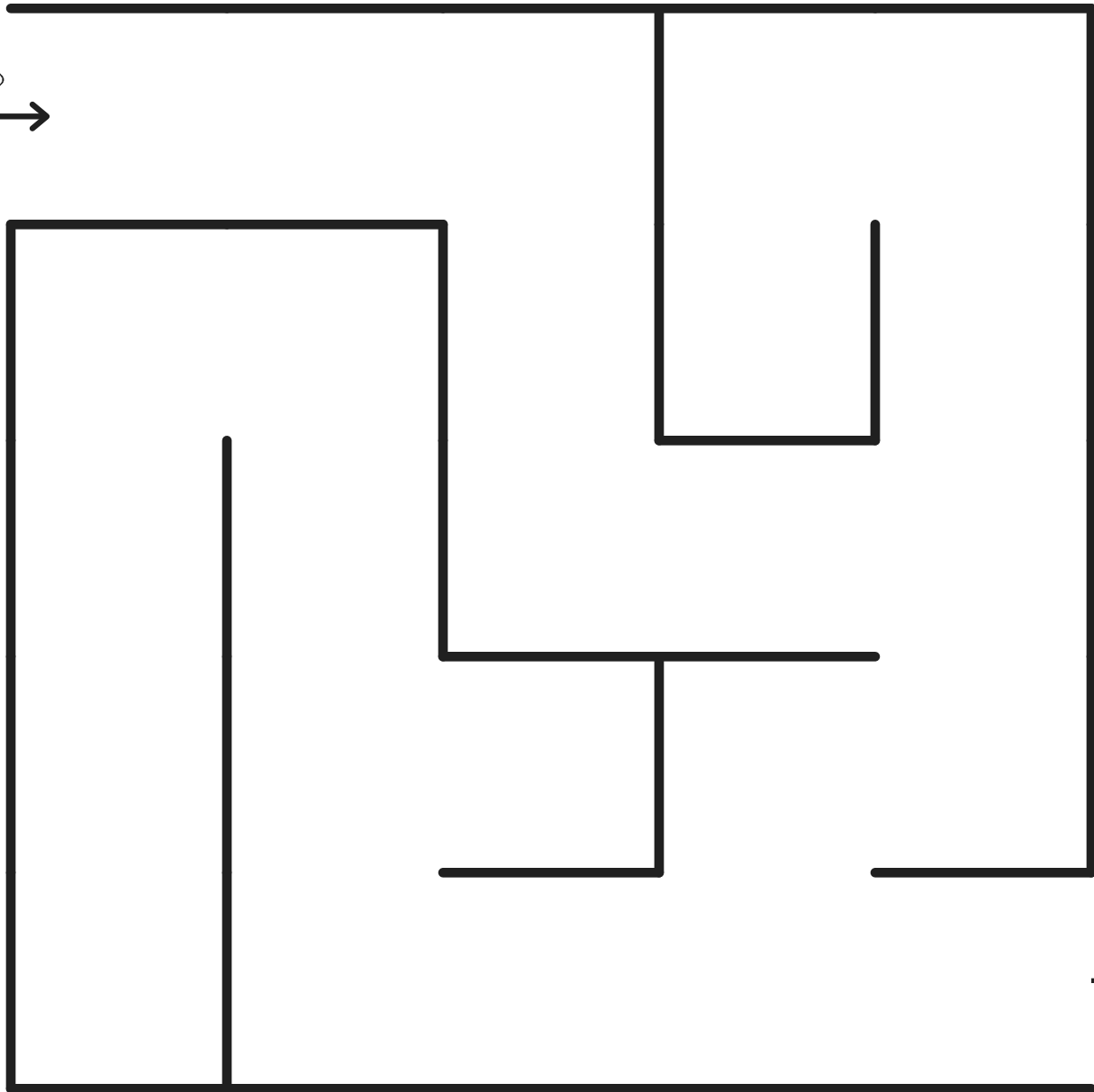
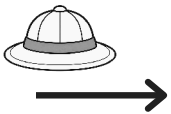

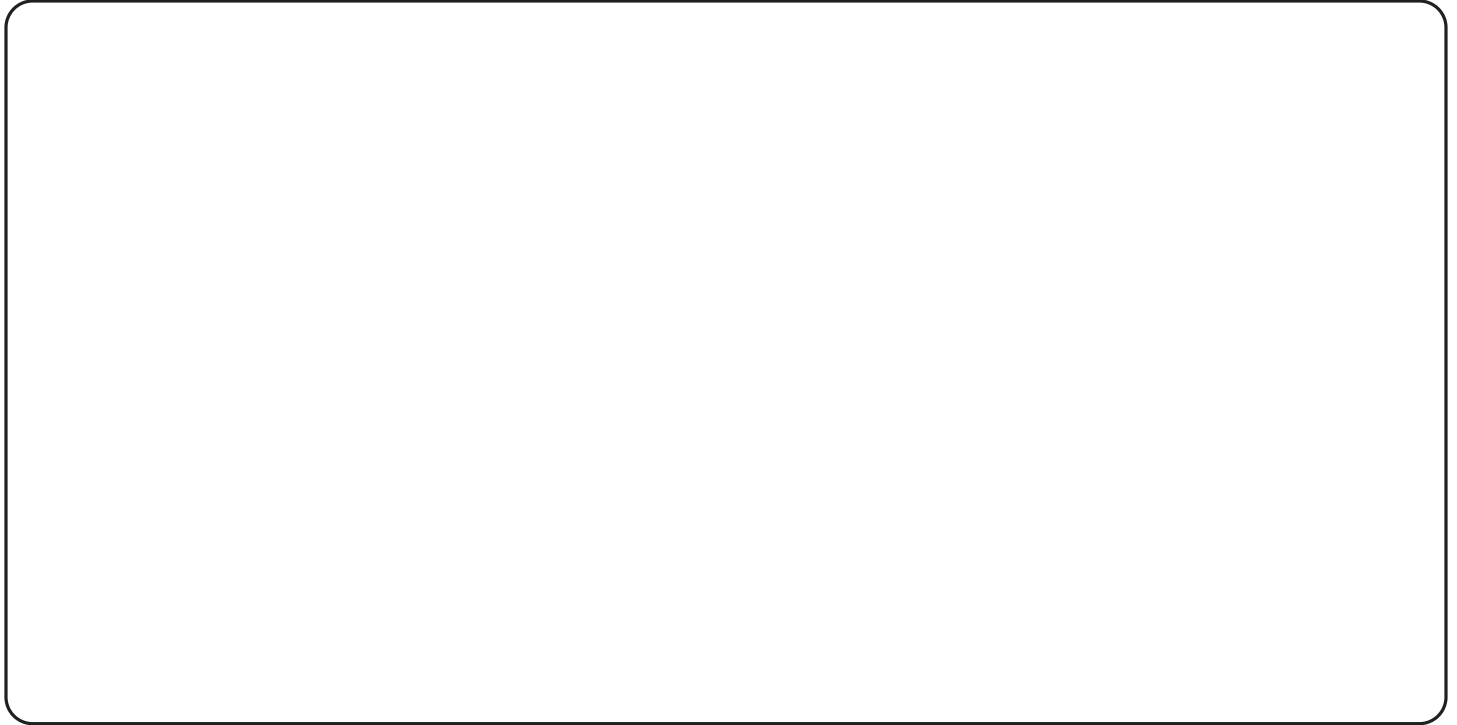
