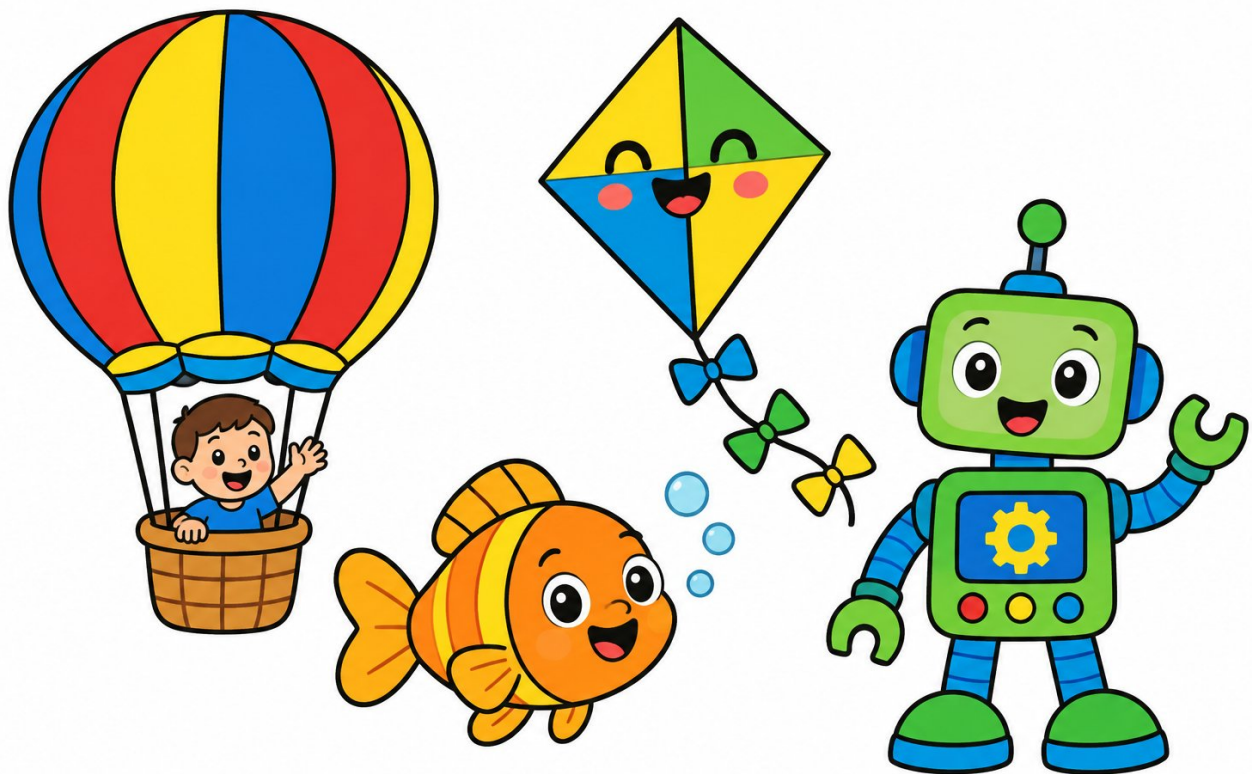


Color by Number Worksheets for Preschool

Grown-Up Guide + Safety

A little matching, a little coloring, at your child's pace.

These pages are practice, not a test.

Start Here

- Begin with Level 1. Set out only the crayons named in the color key.
- Point to a number, find it in the key, then choose that crayon.
- For the first try, color just a few spaces. Finish later if your child wants to.

Help Without Taking Over

Ask, “Can you find the same number in the key?” Point to a matching number or read the color name aloud. Let your child choose the crayon and do the coloring. Staying inside every line is not the goal.

Move Up When Ready

Try the next level when your child can use the current number key independently. If 4 or 5 still needs help, repeat an earlier level. Pause when your child is tired or frustrated.

Safety · Ages 3–5

- Adult supervision is recommended.
- Use art materials intended for children. Follow manufacturer age and safety labels.
- Keep food and drinks away from the art area.
- Wash hands after art activities.

Copyright + Printing Guide

Printing Guide

- Designed for US Letter (8.5 × 11 in). Also A4-friendly.
- Start with 100% / Actual Size. Check the preview before printing. On A4, center the page.
- If your printer clips an edge, use Fit to Page carefully. Check that numbers remain easy to read.
- Print one-sided. Choose only the pages you need; the color cover is optional.
- Built-in low-ink design: white pages, black outlines, and small color-key swatches on activity pages.
- Color printing helps but is not required. A grown-up can prepare crayons using the written color names.

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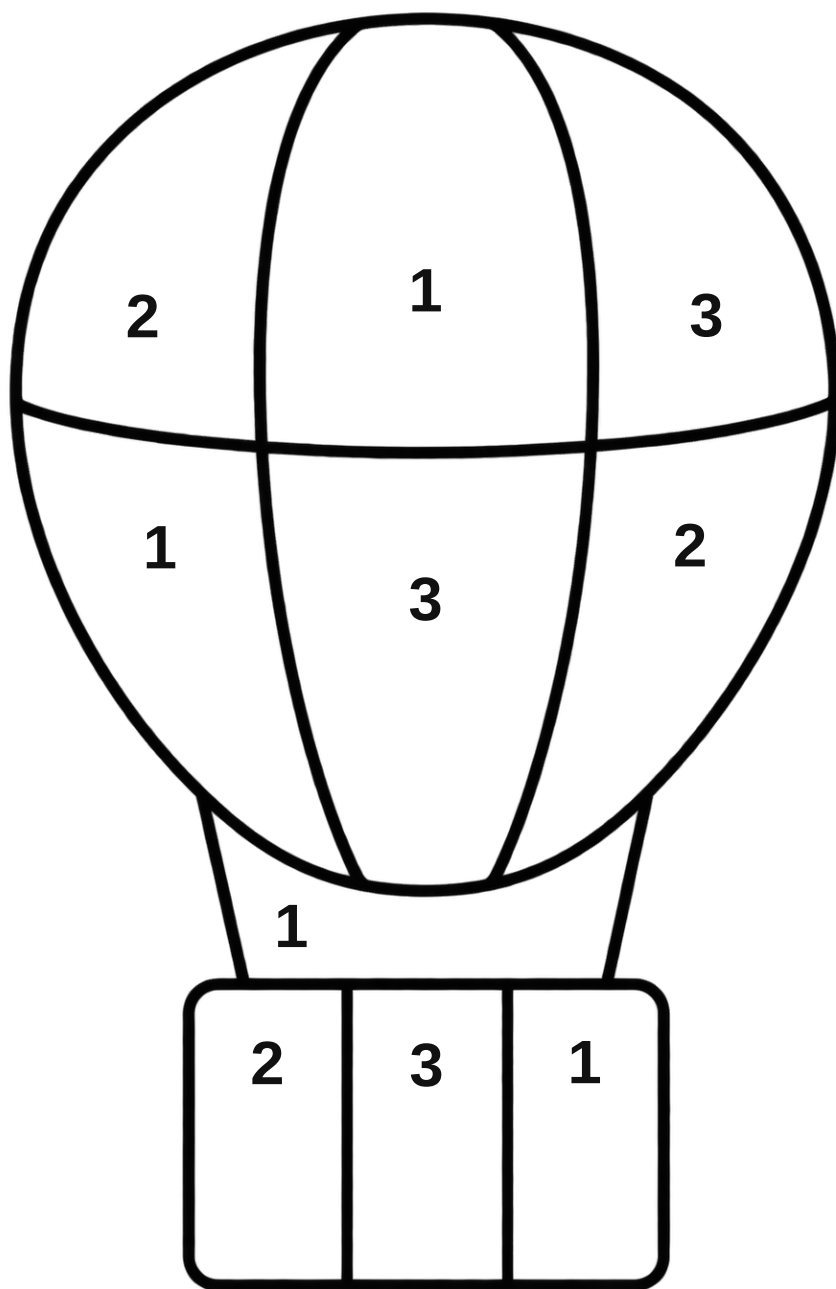

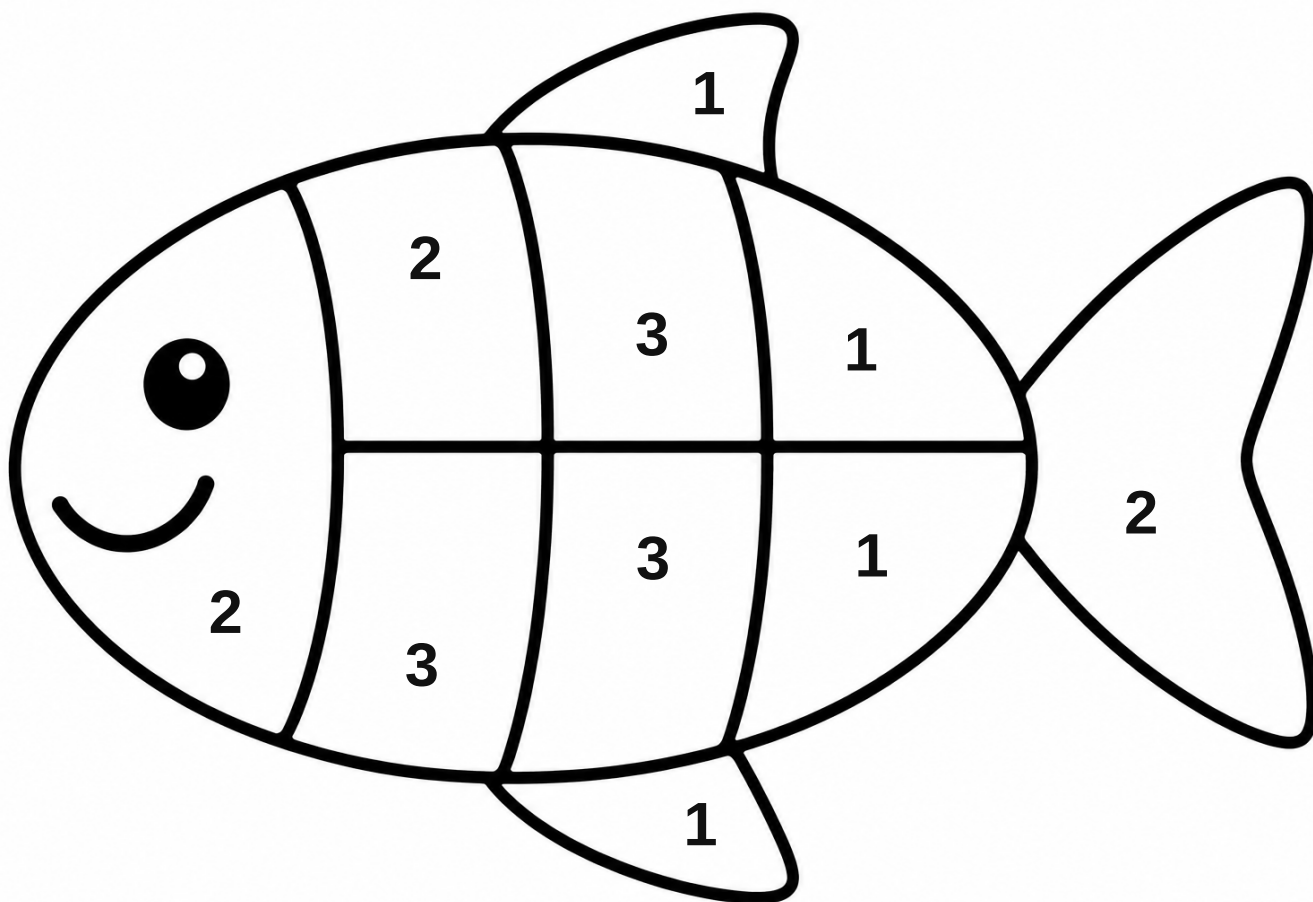

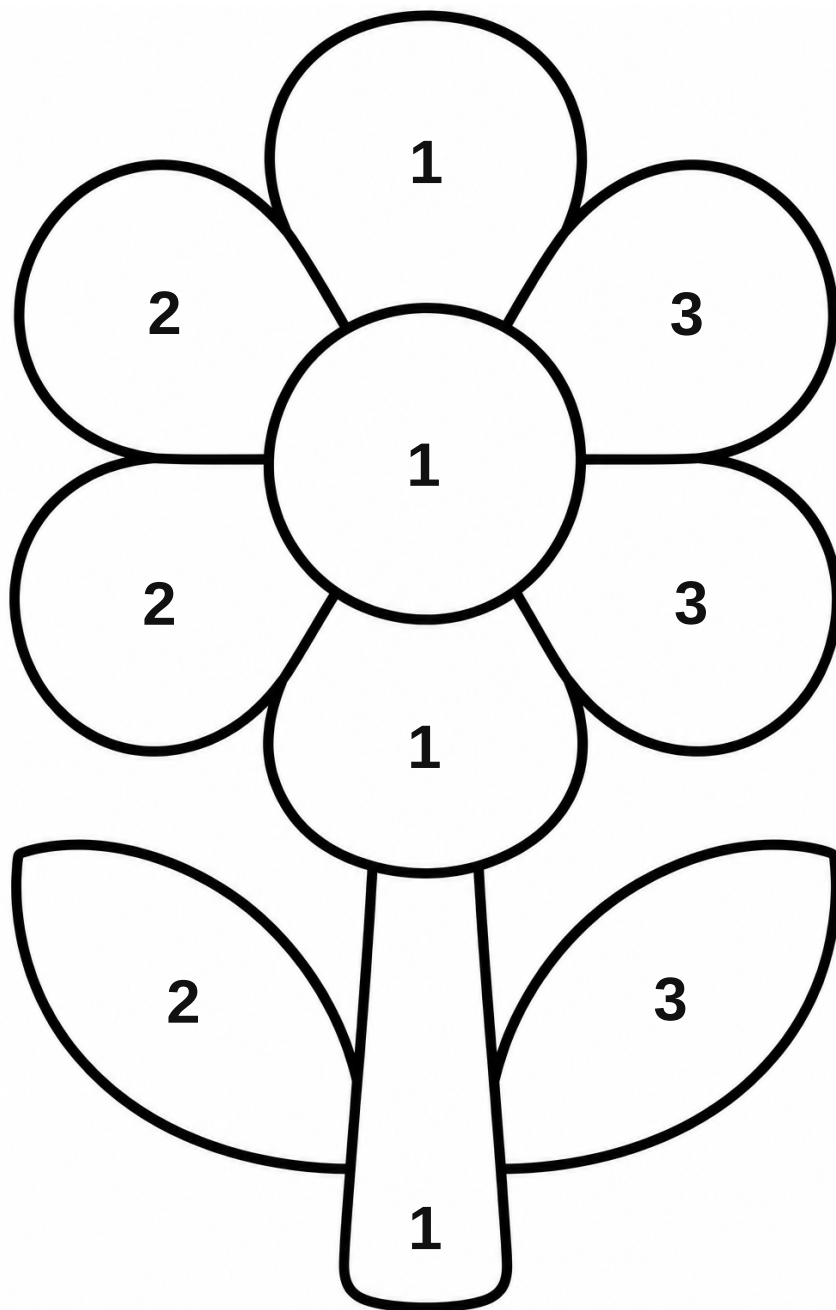

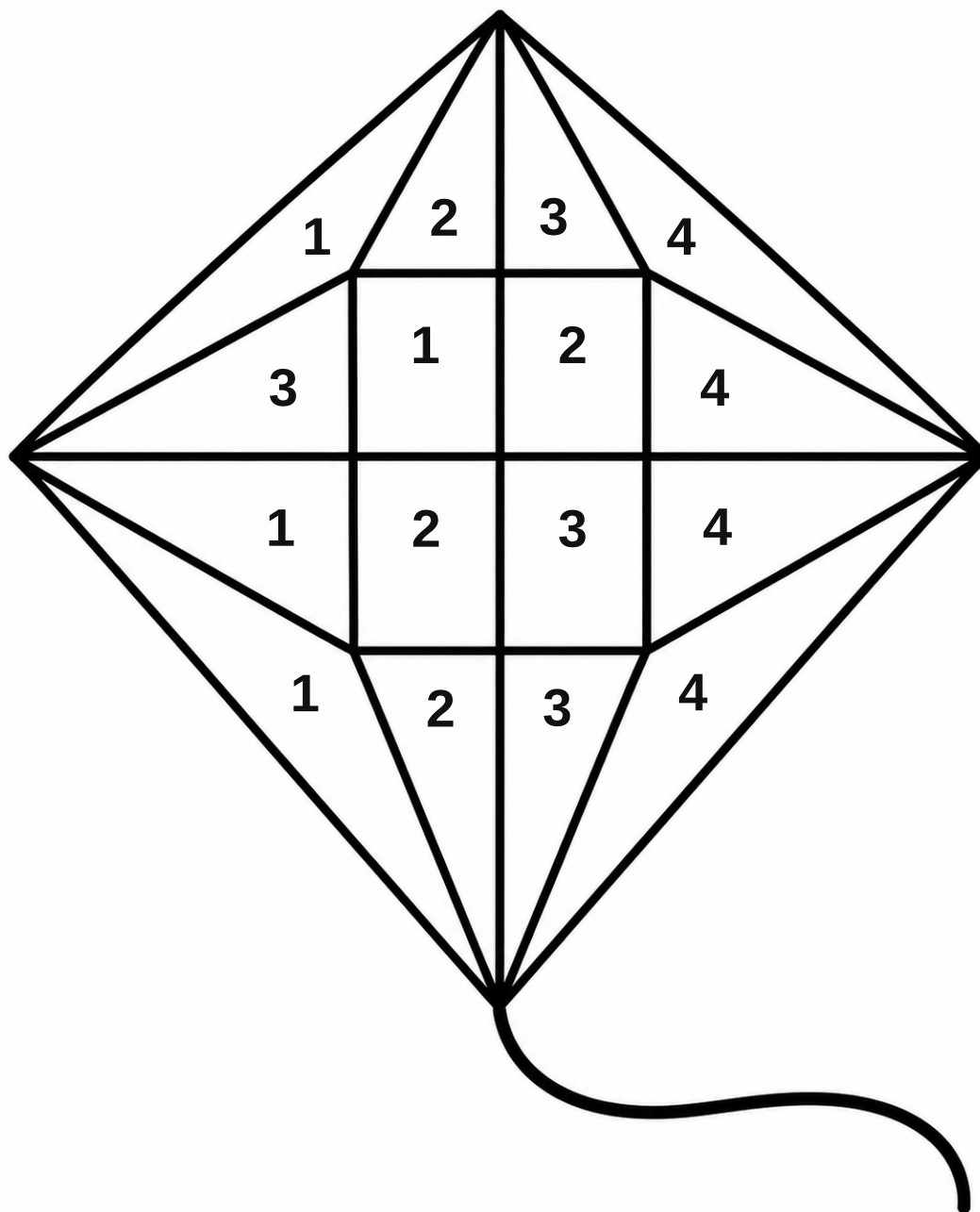

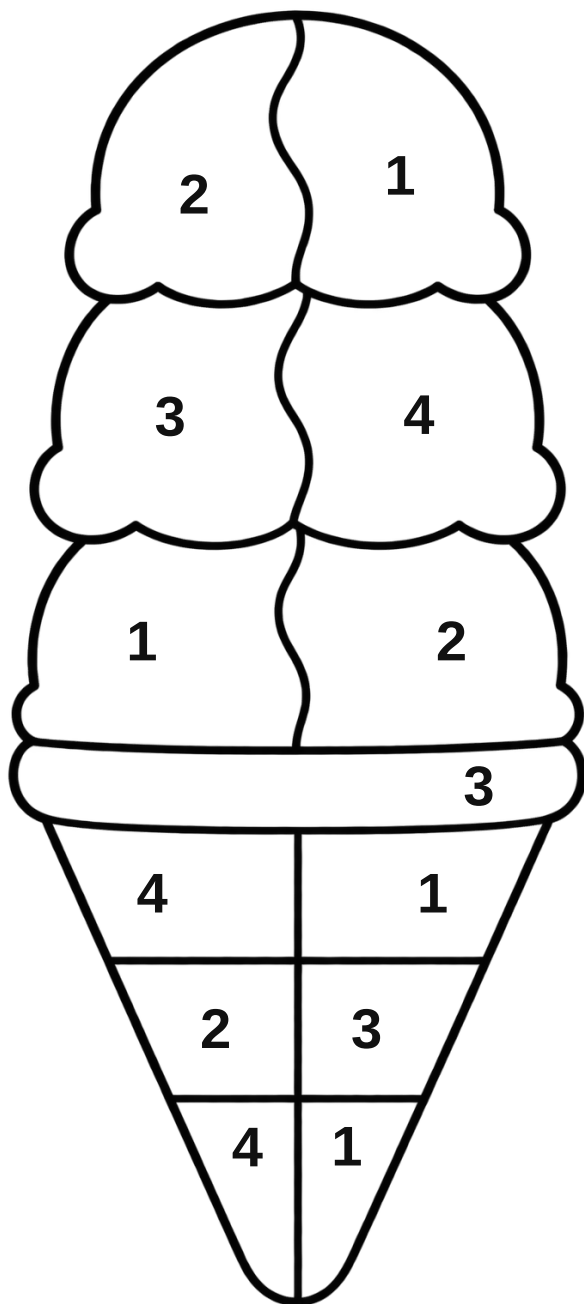

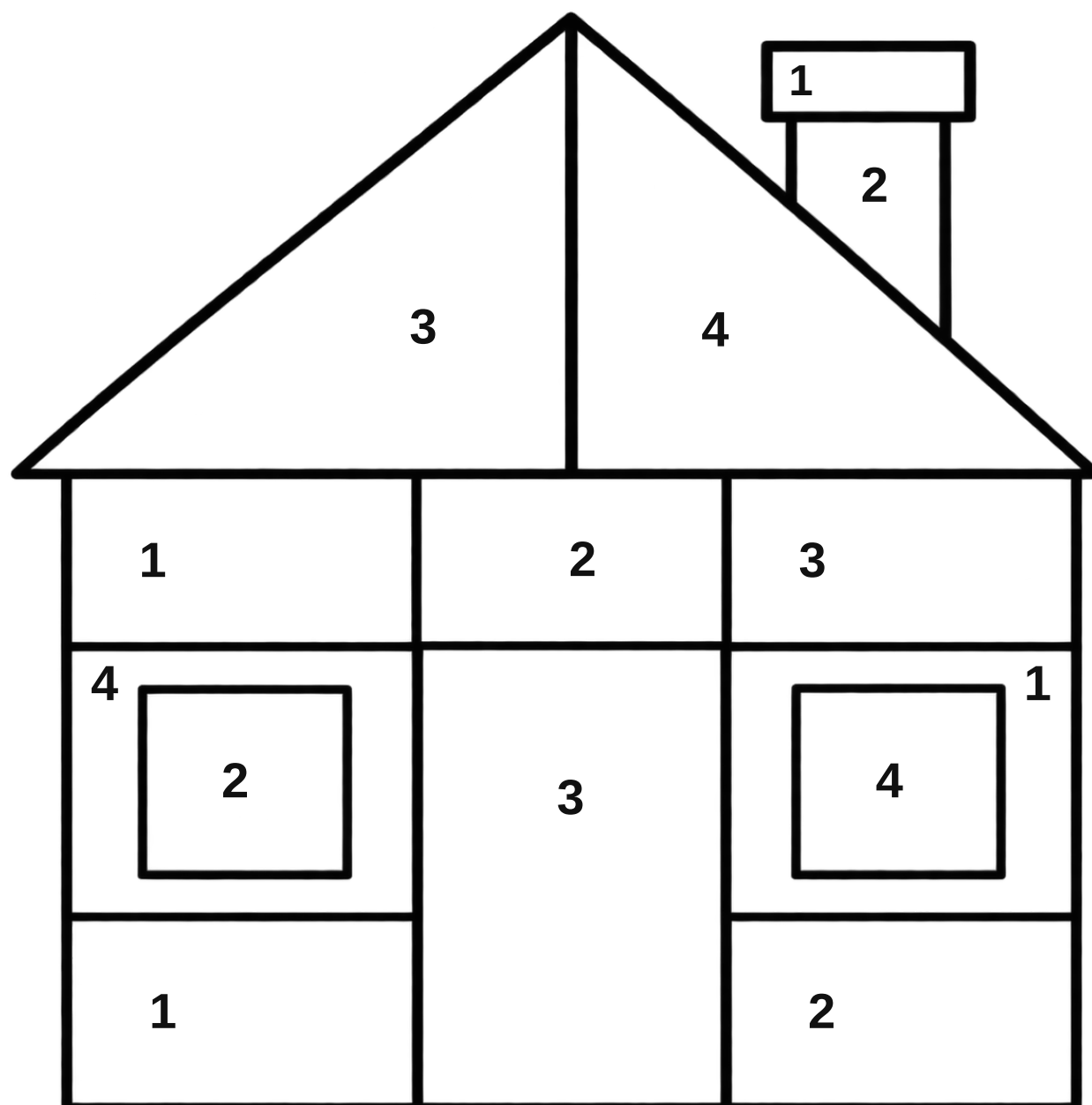

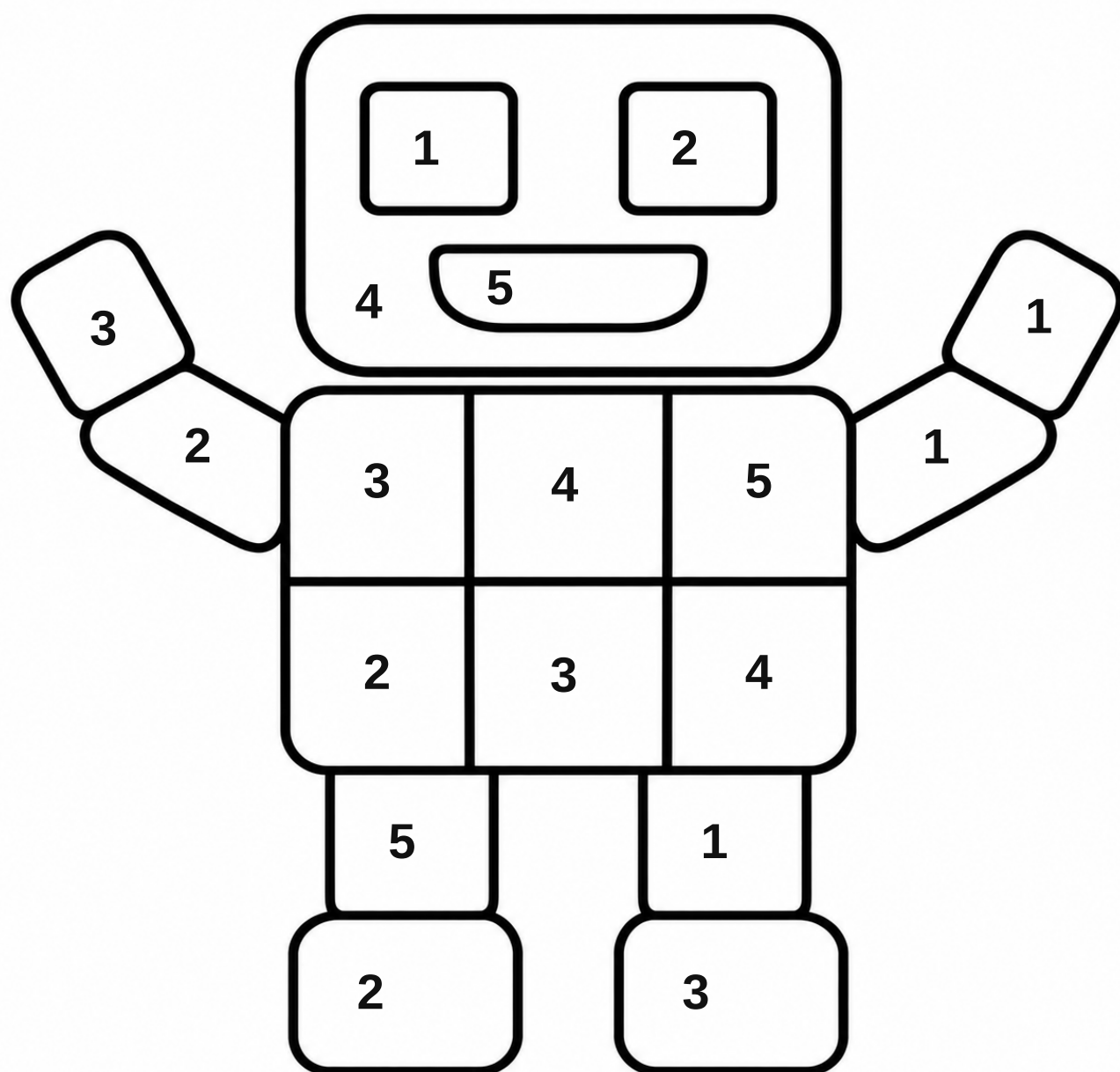

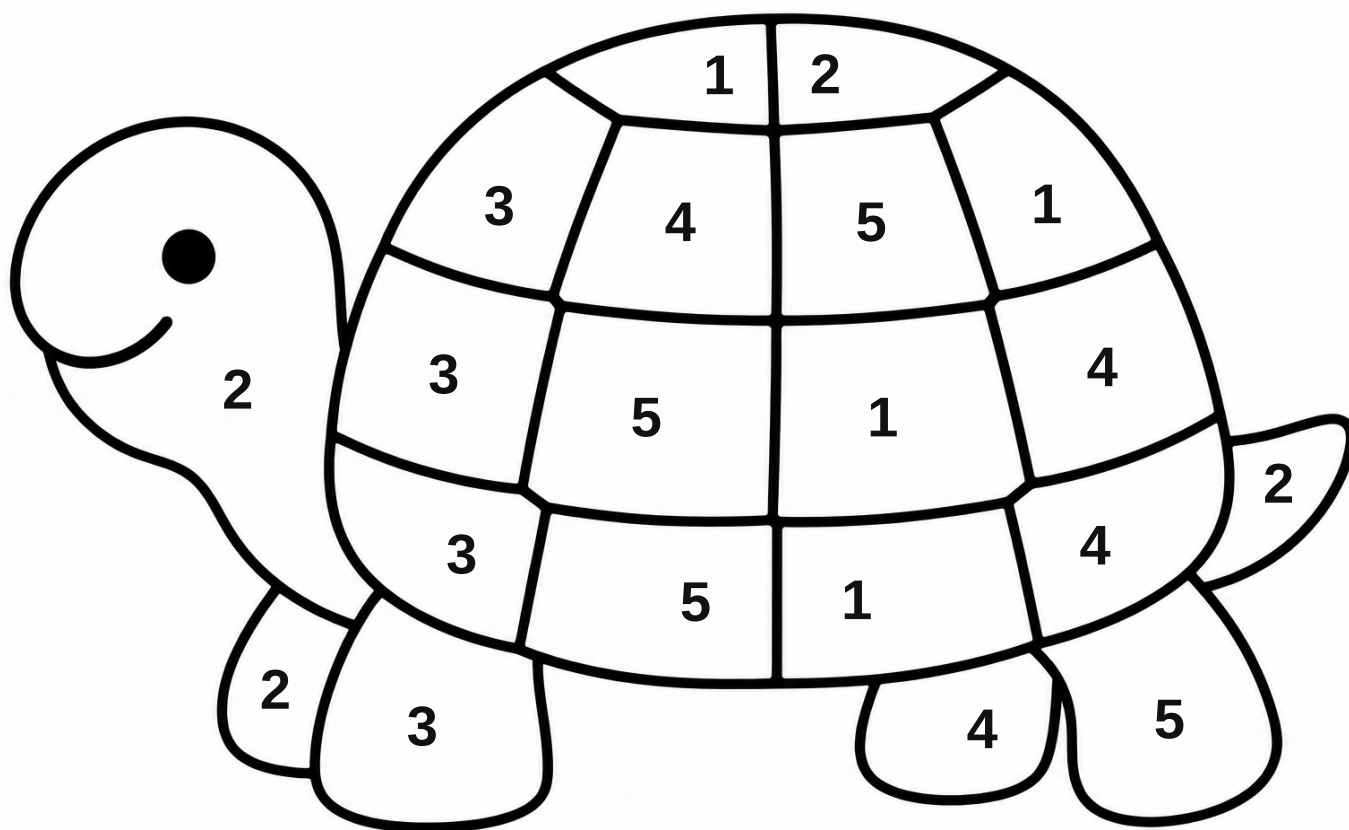

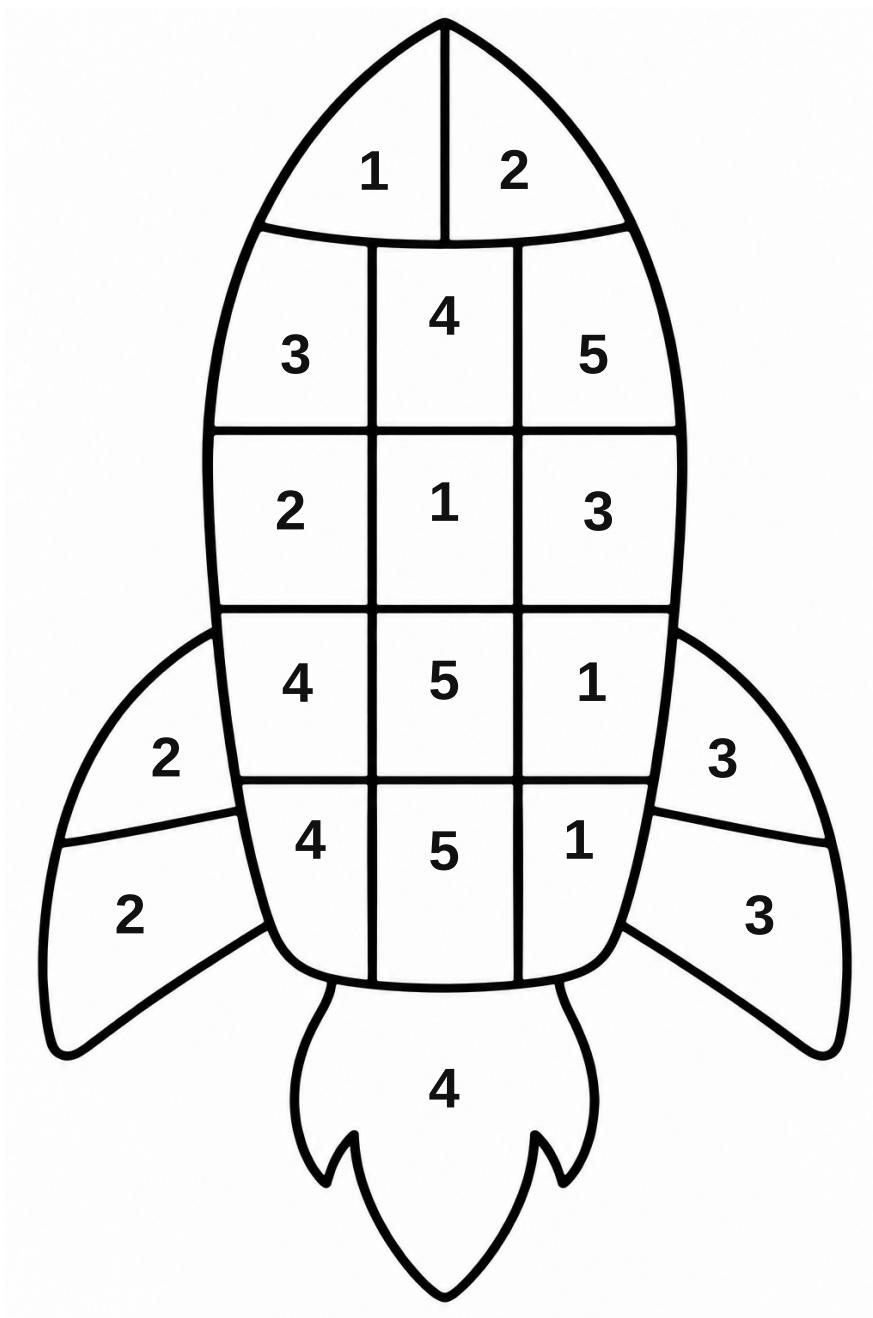

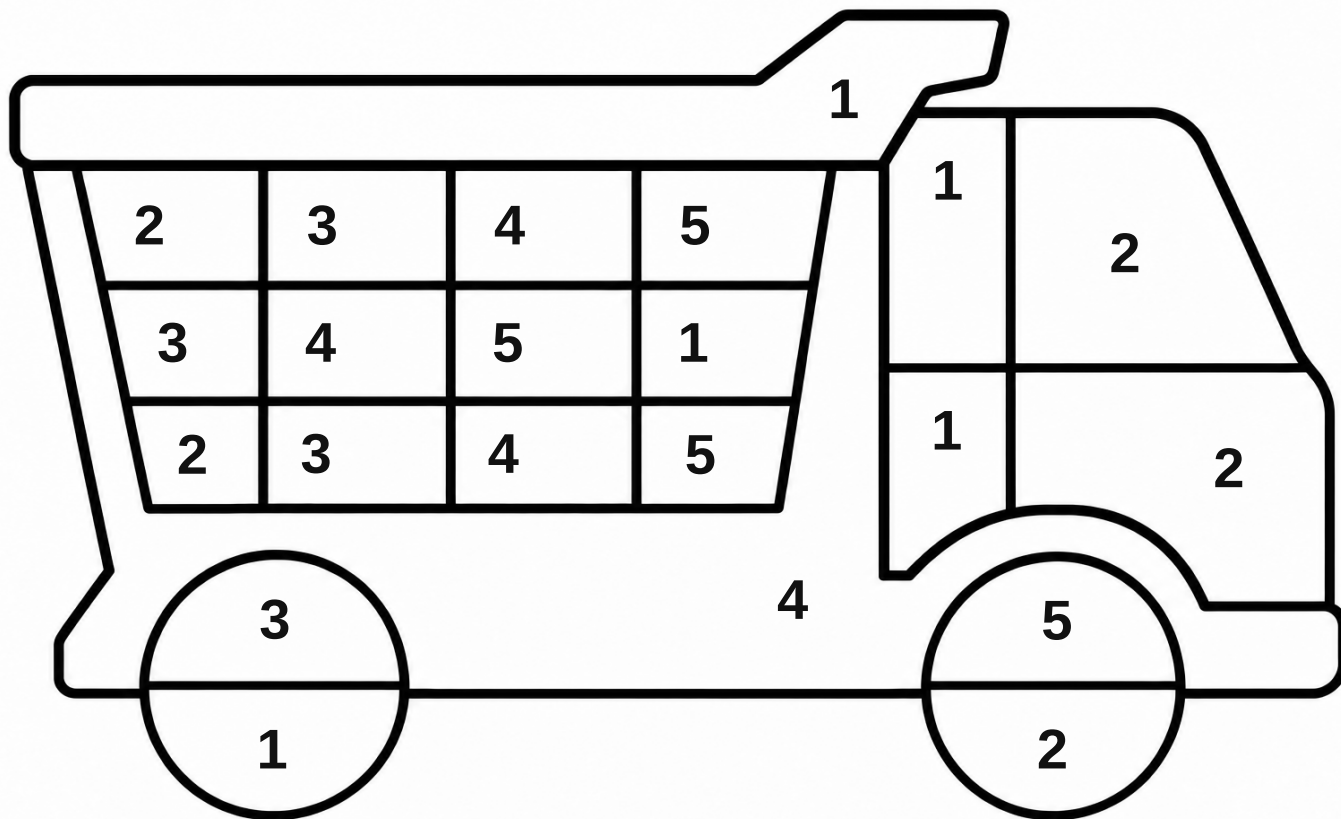

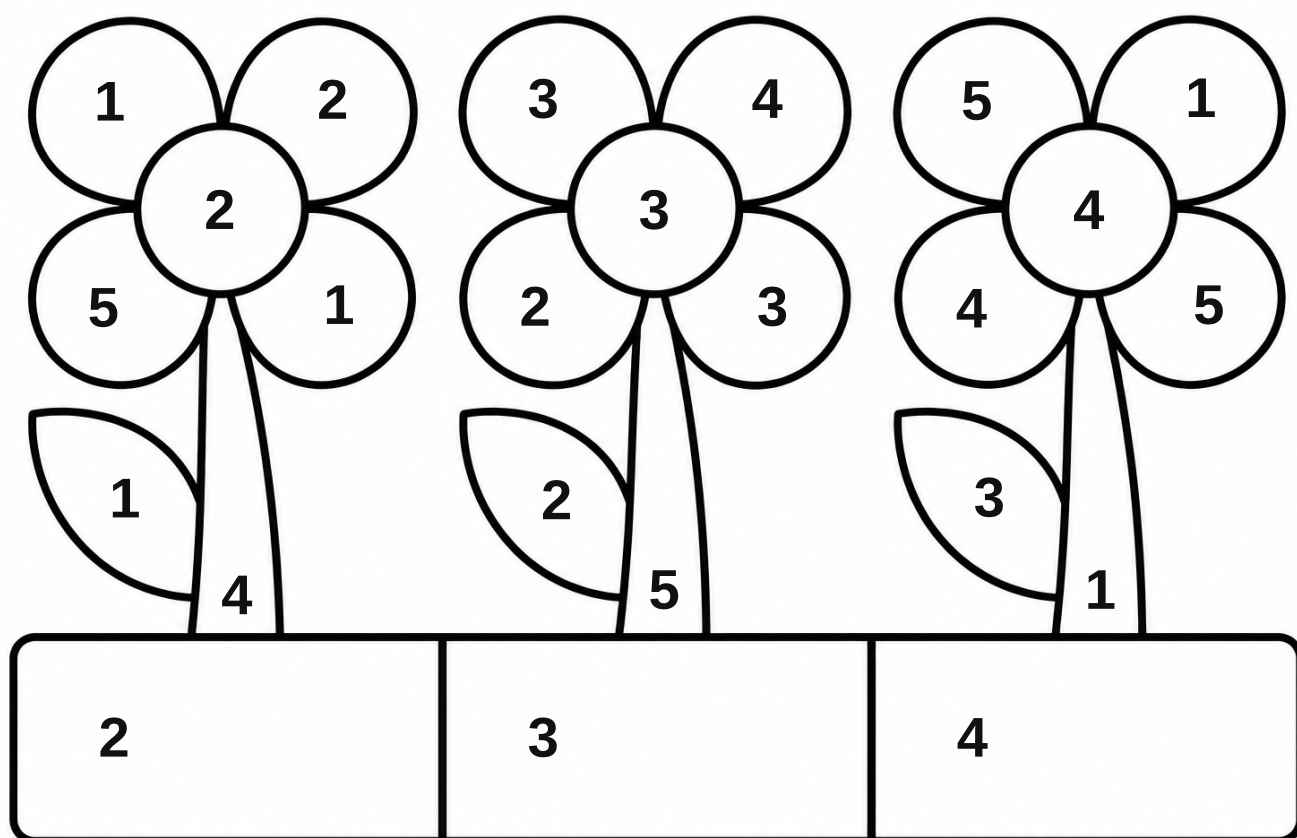
